Who Should Apply:

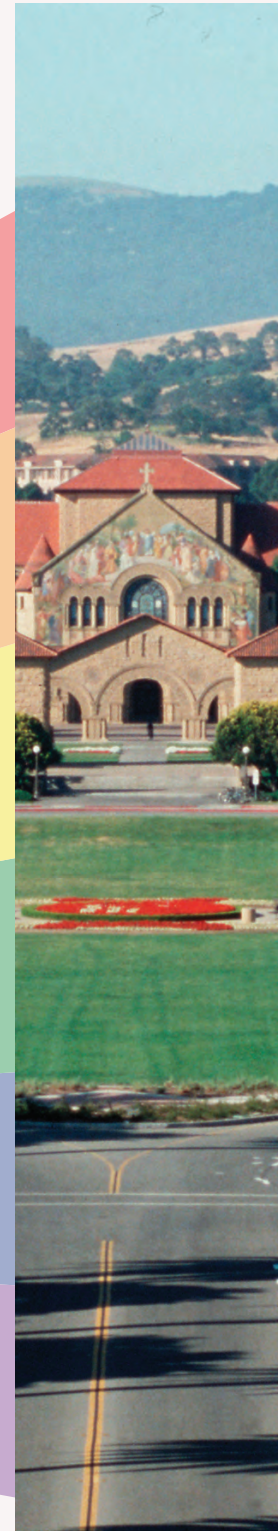
Advanced graduate students who:
