#### Description

This course is a four-week experience in multidisciplinary critical care medicine from the perspective of internal medicine. The student will be expected to fulfill much of the role of a junior level house officer, but will be closely supervised by interns, residents, and a senior critical care fellow, as well as a critical care attending. The unit is a very active critical care facility which manages a wide variety of medical emergencies using extensive monitoring and support equipment. The emphasis is on pulmonary disease, infection, and renal dysfunction, but covers all aspects of critical illness, including endocrinology, nutritional support, cost containment, and ethical issues. Teaching rounds are given daily, and these are supplemented with didactic lecture-discussions several days each week. Fulfills the acute care course requirement.

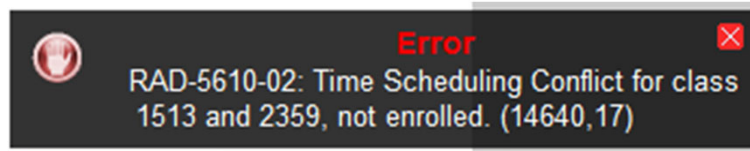

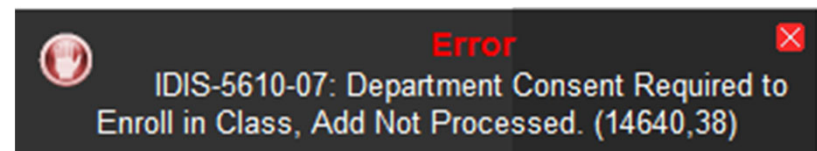
# Most Common Registration Errors

# Waitlist Basics

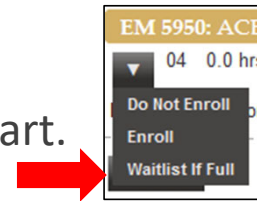
---

## What is a waitlist?

- A waitlist is an “enrollment” in a full class. If and when a student drops a class that is full, the first student on the waitlist is automatically moved into that seat **as long as there are no enrollment conflicts and enrollment for the class is still open.**

## How do I waitlist?

- Choose the “Waitlist If Full” option instead of “Enroll” in your Class Cart.



## Does the waitlist system auto-drop my existing enrollment?

- Not by default; the waitlist enrollment **MUST** be setup using **“Drop-if-Enrolled”**

# Drop-if-Enrolled

---

## What is Drop-if-Enrolled?

The waitlist system does not, by default, auto-drop an existing enrollment if there is a conflict. Without a drop-if-enrolled feature, the following would occur:

*Example: You are enrolled in RAD-5610-11 and waitlisted for EM-5950-11. Another student drops from that section of EM and the waitlist system attempts to enroll you. The enrollment attempt fails because the existing RAD enrollment is in the same section.*

*Example: You are enrolled in MED-5735-01 and waitlisted for MED-5735-02. Another student drops from Section 02 and the waitlist system attempts to enroll you. The enrollment attempt fails because you cannot be enrolled in more than one section of that course.*

**Drop-if-Enrolled** gives you the ability to set 1 class to auto-drop if a waitlist spot opens.

# More About Waitlists

---

- You can waitlist for more than once class in the same section.
- Only one (1) drop-if-enrolled may be set per enrollment.
- Waitlists are intended to help you find a particular ACE or ISC, but not to obtain the perfect schedule.
- Waitlists are purged after the ordinary drop/add deadline
- Coming off the waitlist in a course (e.g. ACE: EM) automatically drops other waitlist enrollments for that course.
  - Ex: waitlisted for MED-5701-03, MED-5701-04, MED-5701-05. Get the MED-5701-03 spot, system automatically drops the -04 and -05 waitlist enrollments.

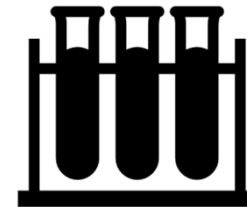

---

- **Enroll yourself in the FLEX month course (*IDIS 0000*) in each section when you do not have a primary enrollment (ACE, ISC, AI, AE).**
- **The VUSM administration uses these FLEX enrollments to track student academic experiences in a given section and comply with federal financial aid regulations. If you're not in an Immersion and not in a FLEX month, what are you doing? 😊**

- Can still waitlist in a section if a cohort's reserved seats are filled
- Saved seats only last until the start of open-to-all registration

## 2. Register for at least two (2) ISCs

- ISCs have a limited number of available sections
- Four (4) ISCs required to graduate
- Prevents scheduling issues in your final Immersion Phase year
- No ISCs allowed in April block (04) of 4<sup>th</sup> year

## **1. Fixed USMLE Step enrollment (Rising third-years)**


- Listed as IDIS-5500-07 “USMLE Step Independent Study”
- Blocks enrollment in Section 07 (July) and Section 08 (August)

## **2. Week-Long courses (where applicable)**

- Fall Week-Long FHD course -- Immersion Phase Year 1
  - Winter Week-Long EPA course -- Immersion Phase Year 1 & 2
  - Spring Week-Long course -- Immersion Phase Year 1

# How to avoid late add/drop

---

- **Own your schedule.**
  - **Monitor future enrollments to know what's ahead to give yourself the ability to be registrationally agile.**
  - **Monitor the immersions for which you're waitlisted.**
  - **Monitor your degree audit to know where you have holes to plug.**

# Degree Audit Basics

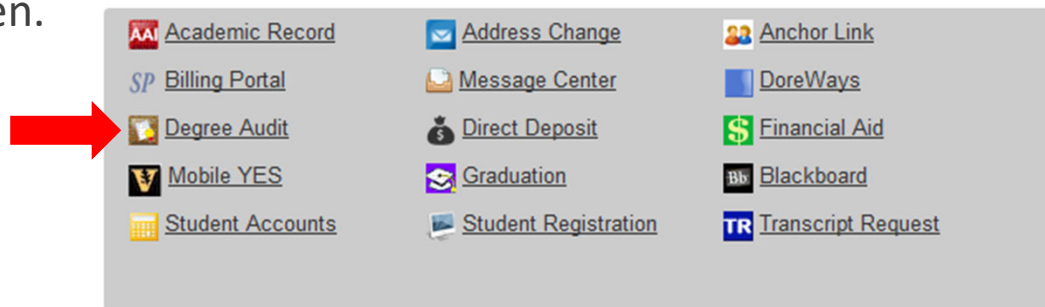

## What is Degree Audit?

- Degree Audit is a visualization of your progress, based on enrollments, through the Medical Doctor degree requirements. It covers all three phases of the curriculum (FMK, FCC, and Immersion).

## Where can I find my Degree Audit?

- Login to YES (<http://yes.vanderbilt.edu>) and choose the “Degree Audit” link from the home screen.



# Degree Audit

---

## **Each overall requirement can be expanded by clicking on the requirement.**

- A description of that component as well as the status of any sub-components (also expandable) will appear.

## **Degree Audit assumes successful completion.**

- In order to properly render, the Degree Audit system assumes satisfactory completion of future enrollments.

## **Satisfied vs Unsatisfied.**

- For each component of the audit, the system uses the color **GREEN** and “Satisfied” to denote successful completion of that requirement. The color **RED** and “Not Satisfied” denote a deficiency.

## **Audits can be refreshed manually.**

- While the system automatically refreshes at least once a week, a manual refresh (to see how new enrollments affect your progress, for example) can be accomplished by clicking the “Refresh My Audits” button near the top of the Degree Audit screen.

# Degree Audit

## Immersion Phase

**Description:** The Immersion Phase is a highly individualized period that builds upon the foundational knowledge acquired earlier, in a context that is most relevant to each student's individual interests. Immersion courses will solidify clinical skills; deepen foundational science knowledge through meaningful clinical engagement; allow students to dive into areas of personal learning needs and/or interest; expand knowledge and skills in leadership and scholarship; ensure readiness for residency; and enhance workplace learning skills. Students will select from a broad menu of courses including Integrated Science Courses, Advanced Clinical Electives, Acting Internships and Concentrations. During a portion of the immersion phase, students will participate in a three- to six-month mentored research experience, tailored around each student's particular research and clinical interests. The longitudinal curricular elements of Foundations of Healthcare Delivery and Learning Communities will remain integral to student development during the Immersion Phase.

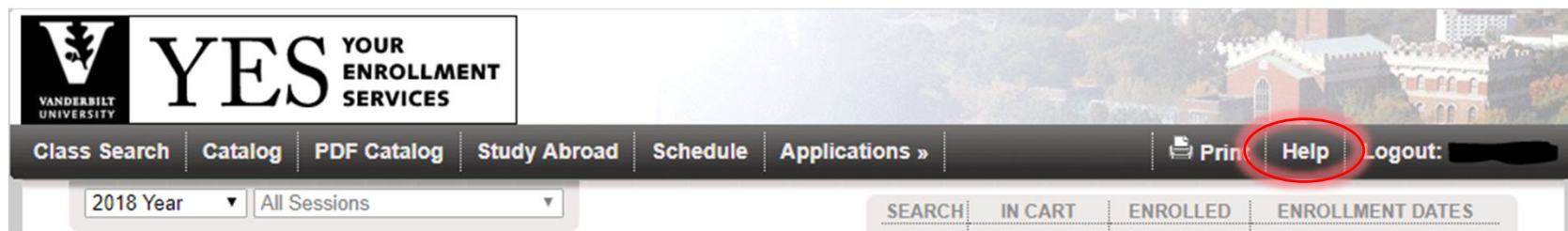

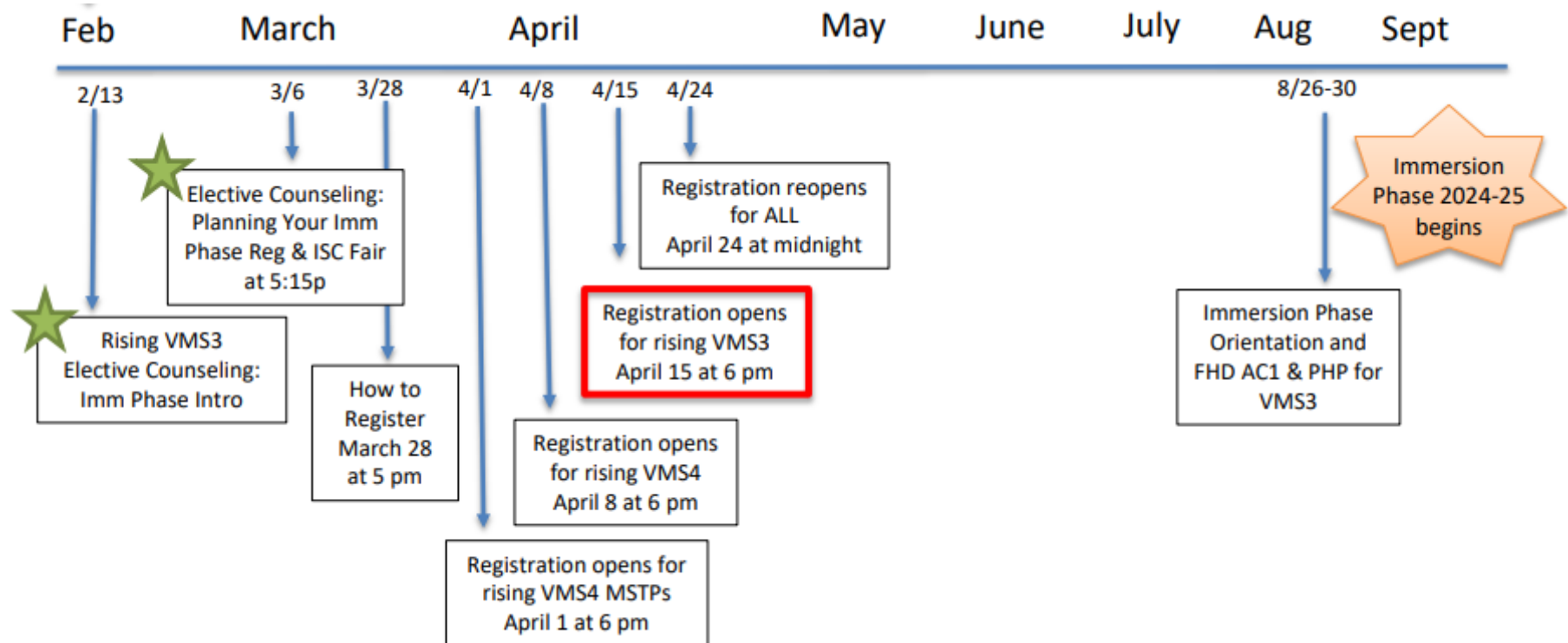
