

After their first term in the program, students in the Vanderbilt MPH Program may take elective courses offered through the School of Medicine and other Vanderbilt schools and colleges. This document is intended to guide the discussion with your academic adviser about which elective courses would be appropriate to add to your individual MPH course of study during your time in the program.

Note:

- This is not a comprehensive list; you may propose other public health-related graduate- or professional-level courses as electives.
- This list indicates the academic term when a course is typically offered. The scheduling and availability of courses may change. Check YES (yes.vanderbilt.edu) for the most up-to-date course information for the current academic year.
- Registration in courses offered by other programs or departments (course codes other than *PUBH*) is contingent upon course instructor approval (in writing), MPH Program approval, and space in the classroom. Check YES for information about pre-requisites, instructors, and class capacity.
