MPH students) and VUMC personnel</li> <li>• Food and drink permitted on first floor by the big windows</li> <li>• Study rooms are available for VUMC personnel and Vanderbilt graduate students individually or in groups</li> <li>• Computer lab with printers, scanners, copiers</li> <li>• Laptop, headphones, network cables and USB drives available for checkout</li> </ul>
<p><b>CENTENNIAL PERK</b> 2525 West End Avenue, 8<sup>TH</sup> floor</p>	<p>Mon – Fri 8am – 6pm</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Quiet lounge space overlooking Centennial Park with tables and sofas</li> <li>• Used by VUMC employees and graduate students</li> <li>• Kitchen area with microwave, sink, and water cooler</li> <li>• Access to the space is restricted in the evenings; after 6pm, elevators only go downwards, from the 8<sup>th</sup> floor to the 1st and 2nd floors</li> <li>• 2-hour visitor parking in the lot in front of the building</li> </ul>
<p><b>LIGHT HALL</b></p> <p>Adjacent to Langford Auditorium, across the medical center plaza from Au Bon Pain</p>	<p>Mon – Fri 8am – 6pm</p> <p>Vanderbilt ID required for study lounge and computer lab</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Computer lab with printers on the second level next to LH 319, Office for Diversity Affairs</li> <li>• Kitchen area with refrigerators, microwaves, vending machines, and small eating area outside of computer lab</li> <li>• Study lounge with carrels on second level, across the hall from LH 303, Office of Enrollment Services</li> </ul>
